FOUR TOWN OF WEBSTER OFFICIALS SWORN INTO OFFICE AT JANUARY CEREMONY

*Town Supervisor to serve two-year term;
Town Councilmembers and Town Justice to serve four-year terms*

Webster, NY – Thursday, January 4, 2024, at a swearing-in ceremony prior to the Webster Organizational and Town Board meetings, four town officials were sworn into office. **Tom Flaherty** was sworn in as Webster Town Supervisor, **John Cahill** and **Jennifer Wright** as Councilmembers, and **Christine Seppeler** as Webster Town Justice.

Flaherty was first sworn in as Webster Town Supervisor in 2020 and is serving his third two-year term. **Cahill** has served on Webster Town Board for four years. **Wright** was elected in November 2023 and is beginning her first term on Webster Town Board.

Judge **Seppeler** was appointed Webster Town Justice in January 2023 and was elected to serve in this position in November 2023. **Cahill**, **Wright**, and **Seppeler** will each serve four-year terms of office.

*"Serving the Town of Webster as Supervisor is truly an honor," said **Flaherty**. "As our town eagerly anticipates upcoming initiatives and projects, including the update of Webster's comprehensive plan, continued establishment of Sandbar Park, revitalization of the West Webster Hamlet, and major projects like the new Highway Department Garage and updates to the Wastewater Treatment Plant, I am keenly focused on the continuation of great progress. I look forward to working alongside town departments, local organizations, and our entire community to make the Town of Webster where life is worth living, now and for years to come."*

The Town of Webster celebrates the first time in town history that the Town Board has a composition with a female majority, as well as the first elected female Town Justice.
