

Webster Neighbors,

As we enter fall, progress on the fairlife project continues to track according to our planned timeline. Below is a summary of current progress, upcoming activity, and community events where you can find fairlife. As always, please reach out with any questions.

### **Progress**

If you have viewed the worksite recently, the progress on the tilt up concrete panel walls is evident. Most of the 400 tilt up panels have been poured and we will continue the process of lifting each into place over the coming months. Structural steel and roofing has now started as we push towards weathering in before winter arrives, which is an important milestone for the project. The first mechanical trades are expected to start onsite in the next two months with utility and process pipework.

You may have noticed that installation of the warehouse racking has started. This forms part of the Automated Storage & Retrieval System where all finished goods are handled and stored through an automated warehouse system consisting of laser guided vehicles and cranes. This is a rack clad structure which means the racking itself will support the roof and walls. We will install as much racking as possible before winter begins and then return in spring to finish the structure.

We have also completed the construction of the sound wall. Please note that the acoustic wall is intended to reduce the sound from the production plant once operational. Construction noise is different and there may still be noise disruption from the worksite as we continue building the plant. With a good run of weather, we have started with the shaping of berms on the north and western boundary of the site.

The Town of Webster has completed installation of the wastewater line to our site. Thanks for the patience shown by all neighbors as Tebor and Boulter Rd were disrupted.

We are pleased to share that the plan for the addition of a right turn lane on Basket Rd. is in the final stages of permitting with the New York State Department of Transportation.

### **Upcoming Activity**

With the weather becoming optimal for planting, we will begin planting trees on the neighbor side of the sound wall in mid-October. It's important to remember this is an active construction site. There remains a lot of clean-up and landscaping work that will be done on the boundaries of the site. Please don't view the current state of the boundaries as being complete.

When we met as a group in August, we talked about some updates that are being made to our site plans. These includes items such as, removing the truck scale building, moving the truck guardhouse, reconfiguring the trailer spaces, increasing the landscape berm width, and updating the perimeter drainage.
